

### **28-year-old arrested for bicycle theft**

At 10:25 p.m. on Friday, Delphos police were called to the 400 block of Harmon Street in reference to a theft complaint at a residence in that area.

Upon officers' arrival, they spoke with the complainant who advised a male subject had taken a BMX-style bicycle and the male subject was at another residence in the area. Officers then located Jason Lacey, 28, of Delphos, at which time Lacey was arrested on charges of theft and was also issued a no trespassing notice from another residence in that area from a prior incident.

Lacey was transported to the Allen County Jail and will appear in Lima Municipal Court on the theft charge.

Two additional passengers, Todd Gengler, 18, of Spencerville and Kyle Hamilton, 18, of Elida were also charged with consuming alcohol while under the legal drinking age.

Both Gengler and Hamilton were cited into Lima Municipal Court for underage consumption.
